

Poulsbo Street Closures During Viking Fest Weekend

Friday, 16 May: Front Street will be closed at its intersections with Jensen Way and with Sunset Street from 6:30 p.m. to 10:30 p.m.

Saturday, 17 May: Front Street will be closed at its intersection with Jensen Way starting at 7:45 a.m. and will reopen at 10:30 p.m. Saturday evening. The barricade at Jensen Way will be removed at 1:30 p.m. to permit the parade to pass through and put back at 4:30 p.m. Front Street will be closed at its intersection with Sunset Street at 10:00 a.m. and will reopen at 10:30 p.m. Hostmark will be closed at its intersection with Fjord Drive at ~1:00 p.m. on Saturday, and reopen at ~4:30 p.m. Fjord Drive will be closed at its intersection with 6th Avenue at 1:30 p.m. and reopen at ~4:30 p.m. Sixth Ave. will be closed at its intersection with Hostmark beginning at approximately 12:30 to enable the parade to form up along 6th. That barrier will be removed about 3:30 p.m. when the last unit of the parade has cleared the staging area.

Sunday, 18 May: Front Street will be closed at its intersections with Jensen Way and with Sunset Street from 10:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

King Harold Vei will be closed from 3:30 p.m. on Friday until 6:30 p.m. on Sunday.

The southern half of Anderson Way Parkway will be open throughout the festival, but can be accessed only by Young Street at the south end of the Parkway.

Except during the parade, residents, business owners, and those going to Martha and Mary will be able to pass the barricade at the intersection of Front Street with Jensen Street.
