



From Interstate 5 (Heading South from Seattle or North from Olympia):

In Tacoma, take the Hwy 16 (Bremerton) exit from I-5. Stay on Hwy 16 over the Tacoma Narrows Bridge (free north bound, toll charge south bound), which will become Hwy 3 after approx. 26 miles in Gorst. Take Hwy 3 for approx. 18.5 miles to Poulsbo, passing Bremerton and Silverdale. After passing Silverdale, watch for the Hwy 305/Poulsbo/Bainbridge Island/Kingston exit (about 9 miles) (it's the second Poulsbo Exit), take this exit. **Note:** Parking is difficult to find in the downtown area on the Saturday of Viking Fest weekend. Shuttle buses have been procured for **Saturday only** to alleviate the downtown congestion. To get to the free parking lots, go to the sixth stoplight on Hwy 305 and turn left onto **Hostmark Street**. (There will be sandwich-board signs at the intersection of Hwy 305 and Hostmark directing you up the hill to the lots. There is a CHEVRON Gas Station at the intersection.) You will then go up the hill ~0.4 miles to North Kitsap High School and Junior High School Parking Lots, for free parking and a \$2 (roundtrip) shuttle bus that will take you down to the festival area and return you to your car when you are ready to leave. See the Shuttle Bus Schedule on this website [*SHUTTLES*] for the hours the buses run. You can also park at Poulsbo Elementary School. To reach the school, continue on Hostmark past the High School and Junior High, until the street ends at Noll Road. Turn right and the school will be on your right in a quarter mile.

If you are arriving on Friday or Sunday, turn **right** at the 6th Stoplight onto **Hostmark Street** and proceed downtown. On street parking can be found, sometimes with difficulty, and two churches on Hostmark provide parking in their lots (for a donation) when it doesn't conflict with their services. Watch for signs. Handicapped parking is available in a lot at the corner of Moe Street and Jensen Way and elsewhere where marked.

From Interstate 5 (Heading North from Seattle): You need to take the Edmonds exit for the Edmonds-Kingston Ferry (Hwy 104). When you arrive in Kingston, exit the ferry and stay on the road that the ferry delivers to (called Bond Road). You will be on Bond Road for approx. 10 miles when you come to a stoplight at the intersection with Hwy 305. Turn left on Hwy 305 and go to the fourth stoplight. **Note:** Parking is difficult to find in the downtown area on the Saturday of Viking Fest weekend. Shuttle buses have been procured for **Saturday only** to alleviate the downtown congestion. To get to the free parking lots, go to the fourth stoplight and turn left onto Hostmark

Street. (There will be sandwich-board signs at the intersection of Hwy 305 and Hostmark directing you up the hill to the lots. There is a CHEVRON Gas Station at the intersection.) You will then go up the hill ~0.4 miles to North Kitsap High School and Junior High School Parking Lots, for free parking and a \$2 (roundtrip) shuttle bus that will take you down to the festival area and return you to your car when you are ready to leave. See the Shuttle Bus Schedule on this website [*SHUTTLES*] for the hours the buses run. You can also park at Poulsbo Elementary School. To reach the school, continue on Hostmark past the High School and Junior High, until the street ends at Noll Road. Turn right and the school will be on your right in a quarter mile.

From Seattle (Downtown): Take the Seattle to Bainbridge Island ferry. When you depart the ferry at Bainbridge Island, you will be on Hwy 305. Stay on this for approx. 12 miles to Poulsbo. **Note:** Parking is difficult to find in the downtown area on the Saturday of Viking Fest weekend. Shuttle buses have been procured on **Saturday only** to alleviate the downtown congestion. To get to the free parking lots, turn **right** onto **Hostmark Street** at the first stoplight in Poulsbo. (There will be sandwich-board signs at the intersection of Hwy 305 and Hostmark St. directing you up the hill to the lots. There is a CHEVRON Gas Station at the intersection.) You will then go up the hill ~0.4 miles to North Kitsap High School and Junior High School Parking Lots, for free parking and a \$2 (roundtrip) shuttle bus that will take you down to the festival area and return you to your car when you are ready to leave. See the Shuttle Bus Schedule on this website [*SHUTTLES*] for the hours the buses run. You can also park at Poulsbo Elementary School. From Highway 3 North of Poulsbo (heading south): Take the Hwy 305/Poulsbo/Bainbridge Island/Kingston exit (it's the first and only Poulsbo Exit southbound). **Note:** Parking is difficult to find in the downtown area on the Saturday of Viking Fest weekend. Shuttle buses have been procured on **Saturday only** to alleviate the downtown congestion. To get to the free parking lots, go to the sixth stoplight and turn left onto Hostmark Street. (There will be sandwich-board signs at the intersection of Hwy 305 and Hostmark directing you up the hill to the lots. There is a CHEVRON Gas Station at the intersection.) You will then go up the hill ~0.4 miles to North Kitsap High School and Junior High School Parking Lots, for free parking and a \$2 (roundtrip) shuttle bus that will take you down to the festival area and return you to your car when you are ready to leave. From Highway 3 South of Poulsbo (heading north): After passing Silverdale, watch for the Hwy 305/Poulsbo/Bainbridge Island/Kingston exit (about 4 miles) (it's the second Poulsbo Exit when northbound), take this exit. **Note:** Parking is difficult to find in the downtown area on the Saturday of Viking Fest weekend. Shuttle buses have been procured on **Saturday only** to alleviate the downtown congestion. To get to the free parking lots, go to the sixth stoplight and turn left onto Hostmark Street. (There will be sandwich-board signs at the intersection of Hwy 305 and Hostmark directing you up the hill to the lots. There is a CHEVRON Gas Station at the intersection.) You will then go up the hill ~0.4 miles to North Kitsap High School and Junior High School Parking Lots, for free parking and a \$2 (roundtrip) shuttle bus that will take you down to the festival area and return you to your car when you are ready to leave.
